This past Tuesday we experienced an election like many of us have never experienced before. Many people were very pleased with the outcome and many people feel defeated because of it. This is a time for all of us to pray for unity and work for the common good as directed by our faith. One of the big disappointments is that Amendment 3 passed which will allow unrestricted access to end the life of a child. As people of faith, we cannot let ourselves become so overwhelmed with disappointment that we give up our efforts to keep fighting for the right to life. This is a call for us to increase our prayers and vigilance to protect all life. This past week we observed national vocation awareness week when we focus on priestly and religious vocations but let us not forget, all vocations to the priesthood and religious life start with the family.
