FROM FR. REID

USAF Reserve Chaplain

Some parishioners have asked about my US Air Force Reserve duties, so I wanted to offer an update. As your pastor and chaplain, my ministry extends beyond our congregation into the United States Air Force Reserve, where I serve as an Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA)

Chaplain assigned to Cannon Air Force Base, New Mexico; home of the 27th Special Operations Wing. This means that I am able to complete my uniformed service all in one 24-day block instead of one week-end a month and two weeks over the summer as other Reservists or Guard members.

From May 19th to June 11th this year, I will report for annual training with the active-duty chapel team. In the IMA role, I integrate fully with the full-time staff: shadowing daily operations, forging relationships, and jumping right into ministry. This structure enables me to faithfully fulfill both my pastoral calling here in the Diocese and my Reserve duties, bringing spiritual care to those who defend our nation.

Cannon AFB serves as a key hub for Air Force Special Operations Command. Its elite Air Commandos train relentlessly for high-risk, often classified missions in austere and dangerous environments. These Airmen, along with their families, navigate extraordinary challenges: frequent and prolonged deployments, intense operational tempo, family separations, moral complexities, and the constant demands of readiness. While there, I will provide the sacraments, confidential pastoral counseling, spiritual resiliency training, and ethical advisement to commanders; all the while being a steady, nonjudgmental presence in times of joy, crisis, or quiet struggle.

While there is no good time to be away from the parish for a little over three weeks—the time after the school year ending and prior to the picnic seem best. I ask you to please keep all our military members and their families in your prayers; knowing that wherever we are called to serve Him, our true Commander equips us faithfully.
